

Singleton Dressage Annual Pointscore Information

In order to be eligible for an annual pointscore prize, riders must meet the following minimum requirements:

- Must be a financial member of the club at the time of competition to be awarded points for that competition. Points will not be back dated e.g. you cannot join in May 2025 and accrue points from a March 2025 competition.
- Membership can be paid in December of the previous year and carry forward to the following year. E.g. join in December 2025 would mean your membership is current from December 2025 – December 2026.

Points are awarded based on the following:

- Points are based on horse and rider combinations in their selected category.
- Horse and rider combinations must have attended at least 2 competitions in the year or at least 50% of the competitions (which ever is greater) held during the year in one nominated level and category to be eligible. E.g. if 4 competitions are held, combinations must have done at least 2 competitions. If 5 competitions are held, combinations must have done at least 3 competitions. *Note, where only 2 competitions are held, competitors must have attended both competitions to be eligible. Should only 1 competition be held, annual pointscore prizes will be at the discretion of the committee and may not be awarded.*
- If different levels are competed during the year, combinations must have attended at least 2 competitions held during the year in each level and category to be eligible.
- All competition points are included for the annual pointscore including members' days.
- Points are allocated as follows for scores over 57%:
 - 1st 7 points
 - 2nd 6 points
 - 3rd 5 points
 - 4th 4 points
 - 5th 3 points
 - 6th 2 points
 - Attendance 1 point (attendance points are awarded for placings where the scores do not exceed 57% and for non-placing combinations who are not eliminated or did not retire)
 - You must have at least 4 points to be eligible. Combinations with less than 4 points are not eligible for end of year champions.
- Where a tie occurs, points will be added together for the next placing and an average awarded. E.g. =1st each combination would be awarded 6.5 points (7 points for 1st + 6 points for 2nd = 13 divided by 2 = 6.5 points).
- Where a tie occurs in end of year points, the highest average percentage will be awarded the winner.
